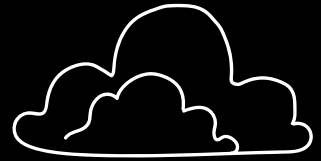


How to Host a Beta Minecraft Server



Requirements:

- Computer with decent processing power and RAM
- Stable Internet Connection
- Java Runtime Environment (Java SE)
- Beta Minecraft Server Software



Downloading Server Files:

- Search for "Minecraft Beta server download"
- Choose reliable sources like minecraft.net

Setting Up Server Files:

- Create a dedicated folder
- Place downloaded server software in the folder
- Double-click to run and generate configuration files

Configuring the Server:

- Customize settings in "server.properties" file:
 - Server Name
 - Difficulty
 - Game Mode
 - Whitelist
 - Port (default 25565)

Starting the Server:

- Double-click the server JAR file
- Confirm successful start in console window

Connecting to the Server:

- Find Public IP Address
- Use Minecraft Multiplayer Menu
 - Enter IP address and port number (default 25565)
